

Part Time MSc in Project Management

This master's degree is offered by Aberdeen University and teaching is at weekends or by distance learning using the Internet. The courses are modular in structure and have been carefully developed to articulate to each other.

The programme in detail

Normally, four Modules per year are completed. Semesters commence in September and February.

Certificate:

This level consists of four taught Modules.

- ▶ Project Management Essentials 1
- ▶ Organisations and People
- ▶ Project Planning and Control
- ▶ Budgets and Financial Control

Diploma:

There are three more taught Modules at this stage and a fourth Module which consists of a group project.

- ▶ Project Management Essentials 2
- ▶ Commercial and Contractual Issues
- ▶ Quality and Risk Management
- ▶ Group Project

Master of Science:

Two further taught Modules and a dissertation which is a double Module.

- ▶ Core Module – Managing Project Teams and either
- ▶ Introduction to E-Project management or
- ▶ Business Portfolio management
- ▶ Individual Project in Project Management
