SUPERVISOR TRAINING



Programme Overview

The Supervisor Training programme consists of a number of short modules, each between one and three days duration. It is delivered through ECITB's network of Approved Training Providers.

This is a challenging programme to develop existing and potential supervisors. The outcome of the programme is the achievement of an ECITB Certificate of Training for successful completion of each module.

Target Audience and Prerequisites

The Supervisor Training programme is designed for new and experienced Supervisors and other first line managers with little or no previous training. Those with temporary Supervisor duties (eg during periods of shutdown/outages) will also benefit. There are no prerequisites for individuals to attend Supervisor Training Modules

Programme Content

Each module is a standalone course which may be taken in any order, although Module 1 (Foundation) is recommended as the place to start. Content of each module is described below.
