The urgency to tackle climate change has placed the UK's renewable energy industry centre stage. The Government's '10 Point Plan for a Green Industrial Revolution' aims to create 250,000 green jobs, generate 40 GW of offshore wind electricity by 2030 and deliver new and advanced nuclear power. The ECITB is committed to supporting the plan by investing in the skills which will be required to realise the ambition.
