

# **Giving Supervisors the Edge**

### ECITB updates Supervisor Training

Supervisor Training has been one of the most consistently in-demand ECITB products for more than 15 years. Thanks to the work by some of our providers it was the first ECITB programme to be offered through a virtual classroom during lockdown in 2020, with over 200 virtual delegate attendances on the modules in place at that time.

It has been updated several times during its life, and a further update was completed during 2020. The content and delivery have been refreshed to include more current behavioural content, and the new programmes are designed to work more effectively in a virtual classroom environment.

The new programme has been developed as 3 modules by focussing on the most important areas (as perceived by employers) in the current programme and has the theme of 'Giving Supervisors the Edge'.

- 9. Detail the supervisor's legal responsibilities in the work environment
- 10. Explain the supervisor's commercial responsibilities

- 1. Describe effective performance management and associated techniques & methods for delivery
- 2. Describe how to use tailored written and verbal communication for delivery of messages
- 3. Explain Management of Change in the work environment and what is required to achieve effective outcomes
- 4. Identify how teams change, develop and present challenges
- 5. Explain the term Human Factors and why this is relevant in the work environment
- 6. Describe the consequences of experiencing an incident/unplanned event and how to prevent these
