## Work Ready Programme

The ECITB Work Ready Programme is designed to tackle skills shortages across the Engineering Construction Industry and support individuals into employment.

Work Ready is a collaborative and co-funded partnership between local training providers, employers, the ECITB and applicant referral agencies.

The programme comprises 13 weeks training at the provider and a guaranteed job, subject to successful programme completion, for the right candidates.

The first cohort of Work Ready Trainee Maintenance Operatives was delivered by NETA in 2023. They acheived a 90% completion rate and all of those that completed, secured employment.

## **Extending the Work Ready programme**

The ECITB is looking to extend the programme across the UK. It is calling to training providers and employers to get involved.



## **Developing work-ready skills**

Upon successful completion of the programme learners will achieve a Diploma in Performing Engineering Operations and employability skills training. They will also receive work-ready skills and ECITB certification including:

- CCNSG Safety Passport
- Manual handling
- Handheld and abrasive wheels
- Working in low risk confined space
- Working at height
- Working safely with hand power tools and equipment
- Mechanical Joint Integrity
- Rigging
- ECITB Digital Passport (delivered through online learning) includes:
  - Using devices and handling information
  - Creating and editing documents and spreadsheets
  - Digital communication
  - Correspondence and presentations
  - Online safety



Following their training, and subject to successful programme completion, learners could secure employment in the engineering construction industry and progress to craft or technician tradesperson.
